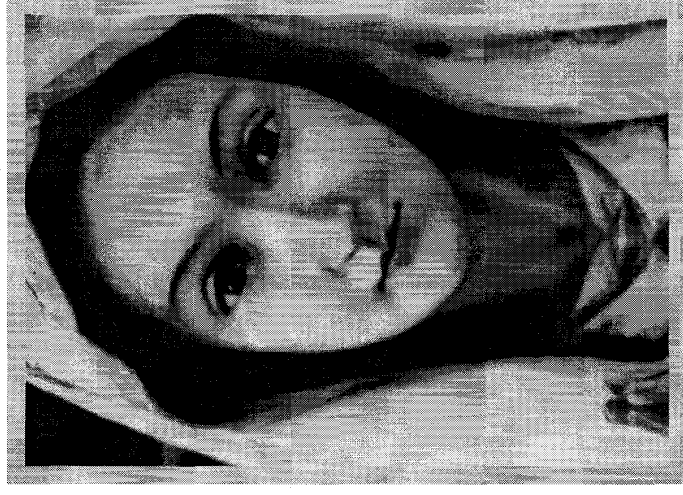
A confirmation letter will be sent to registered participants prior to the event with directions and list of what to bring.
